WHAT ARE TESTBEDS?

Services that enable health technology companies to develop and validate their products in collaboration with health care service providers

Access to an authentic clinical environment

- Connects companies with experts and infrastructure
- Platforms for education and research collaboration aiming at mutual benefits
- Provide clear processes and co-operation models




WHY COLLABORATE WITH TESTBEDS?

- Early feedback to ideas, user priorities and intended use
- Understanding clinical environment
- Supporting design decisions and prototyping
- Testing and clinical validation
- Post-market feedback

PROCESS WITH TESTBEDS

- Initial contact
- Assessment – meeting basic requirements
- Planning – protocol, timetable, resources, permissions
- Contract – terms and costs
- Execution




