THE HUGO AWARDS

Supported by disgruntled group that has historically held privilege and power.

Angry group of conservatives (Sad Puppies) paving the way for a more dangerous and vicious group (Rabid Puppies).

Leader with derogatory views, possibly playing a character that is willing to incite chaos for attention.

A flawed electoral process that allows for disproportionate representation: anyone with forty dollars can vote, making it easy to form a bloc.

Electoral hijacking through vote manipulation by the Puppies.

2016 U.S. ELECTIONS

Supported by disgruntled group that has historically held privilege and power.

Angry group of conservatives (The Tea Party) paving the way for a more dangerous and vicious group (Alt-Right).


Leader with derogatory views, possibly playing a character that is willing to incite chaos for attention.

A flawed electoral process that allows for disproportionate representation: the Electoral College determines the winner, not the popular vote.










